

# Funeven Olympics Impact Review

## Summary

Funeven Ltd and its Directors have undertaken a review of the potential impact of the Olympics on the Funeven site. The impacts are several and potentially severe. Principally, there will be:

- 1) access restrictions imposed by the Olympic Road Network
- 2) potential security problems imposed by the risk to the site from external threats
- 3) planned restrictions on the working on the site for the installation of new duct systems
- 4) increased security procedures during and in advance of the Olympic/Paralympic period
- 5) potential impact of increased pedestrian flows, particularly associated with the DLR stations.

Funeven intends to produce monthly Impact Review Bulletins.
